*Therefore, we proudly dedicate this 1983 Oasis to Dr. and Mrs. A. Elwood Sanner,*

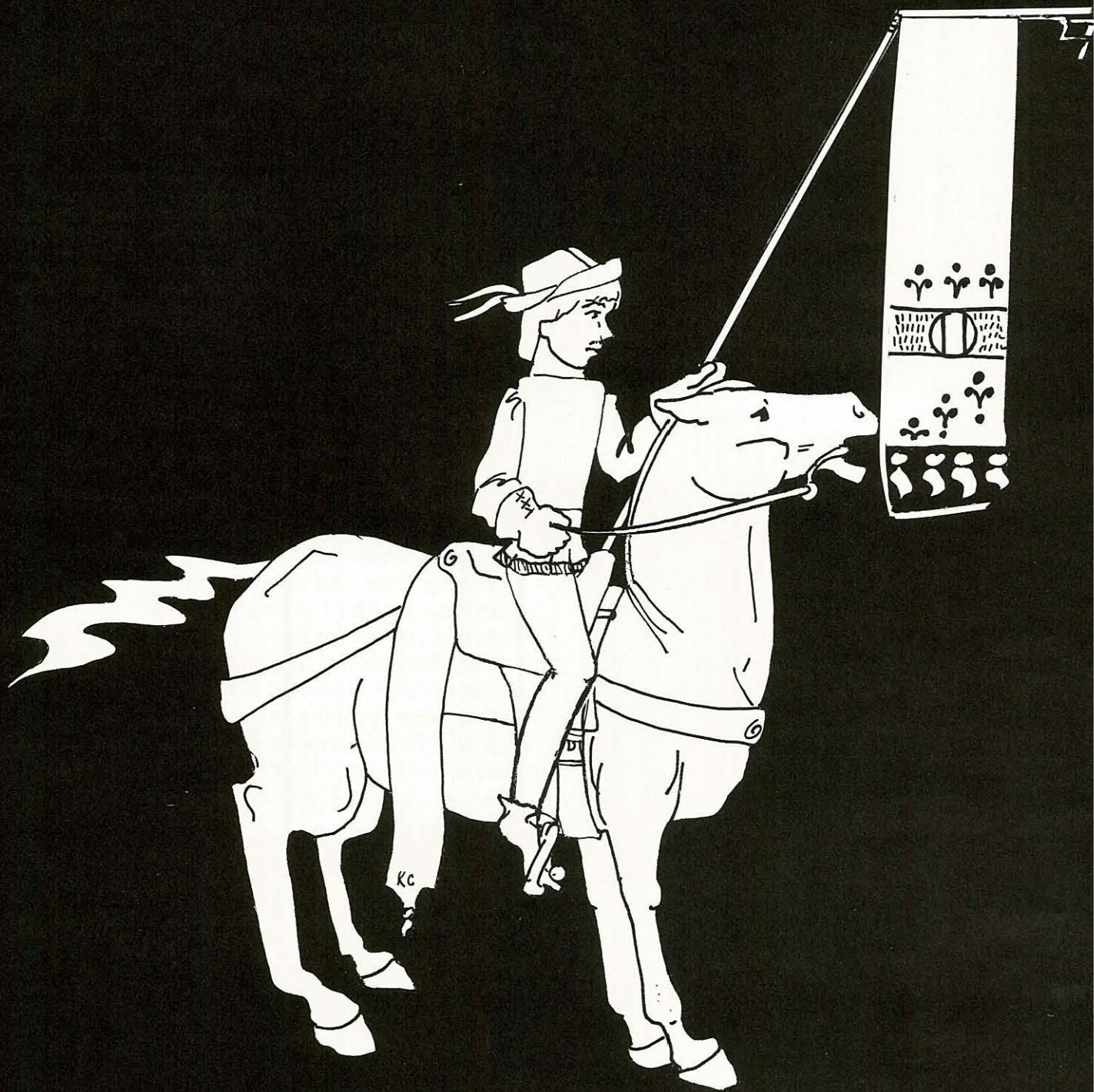

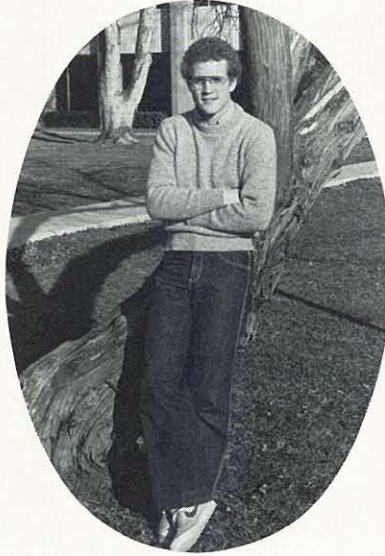

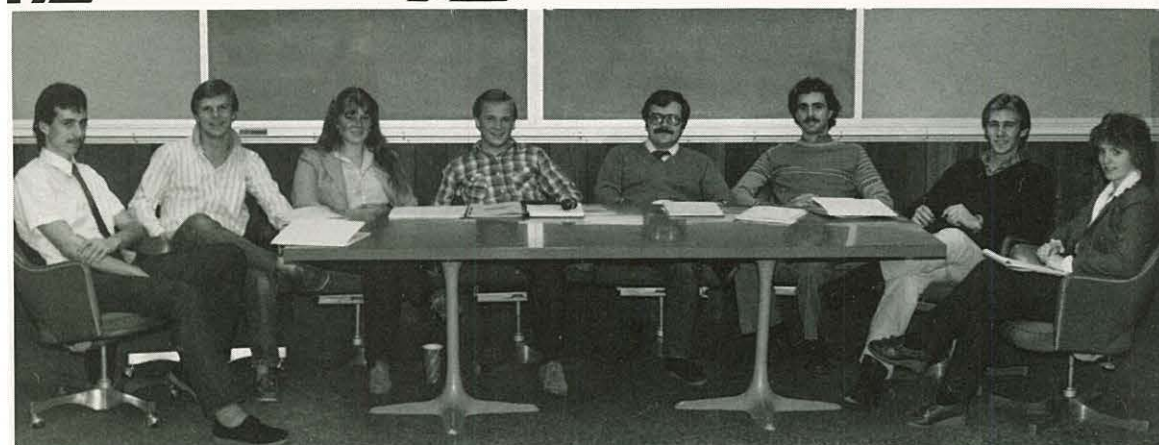
### Attorney General: Bryan Wheeler

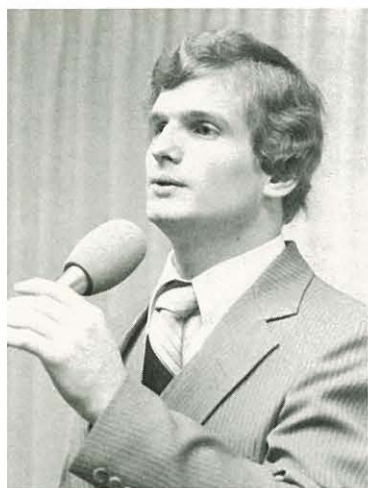


# Brotherhood

# Hunger Awareness Group

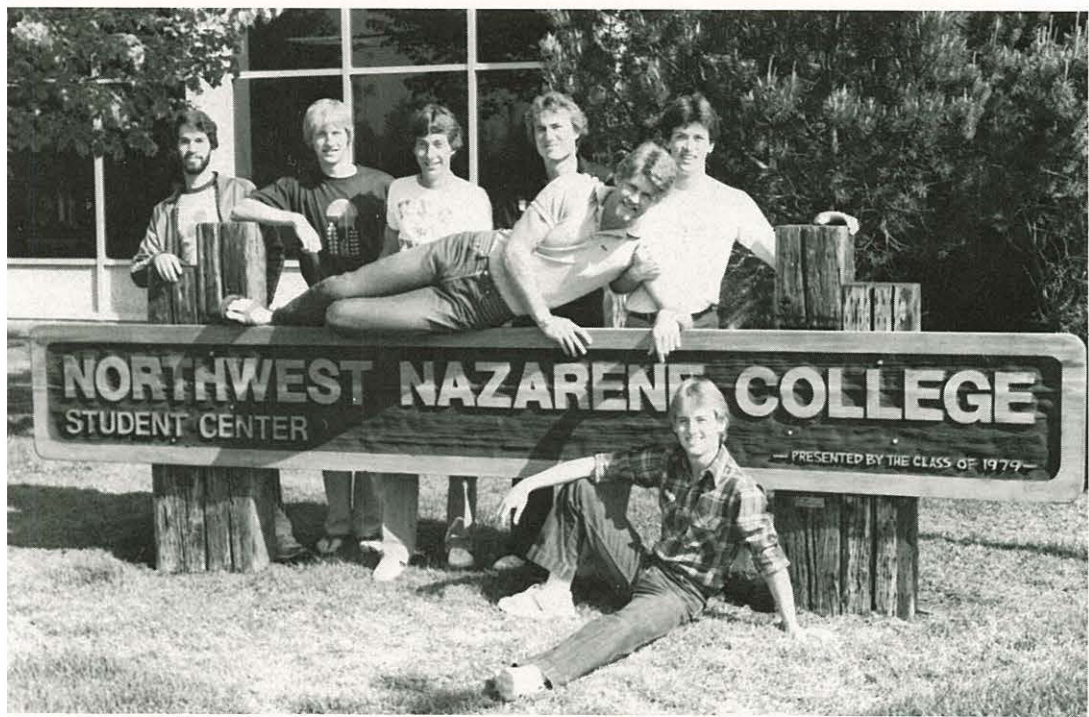

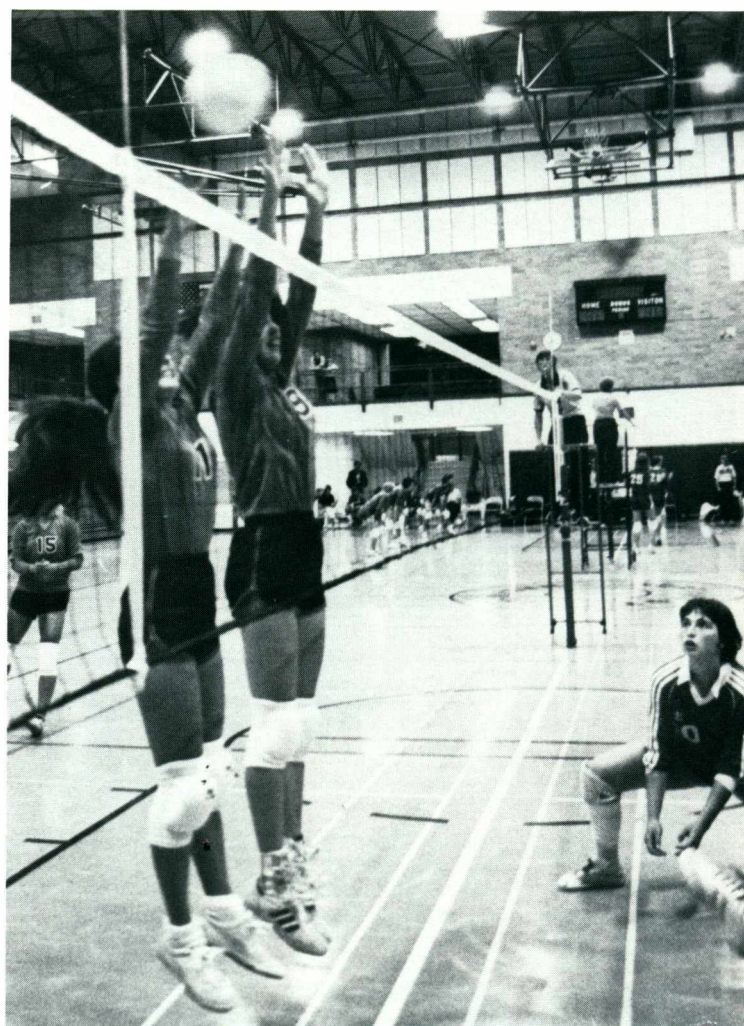








## BUILDING YEAR FOR NETTERS

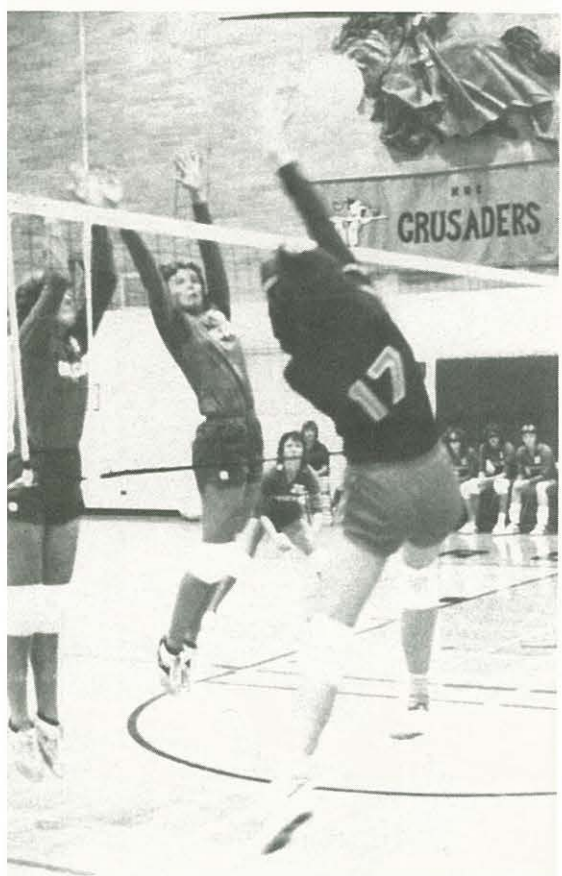

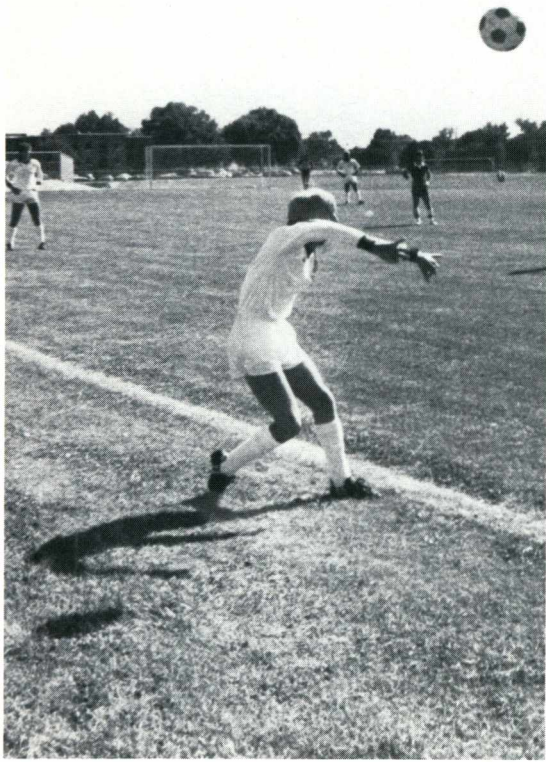


# YOUNG TEAM LOOKING AHEAD

*The 1982-83 Men's Basketball Team, under the new leadership of head coach Gary Matlock and Gary Lawson, finished their season 20-10.*

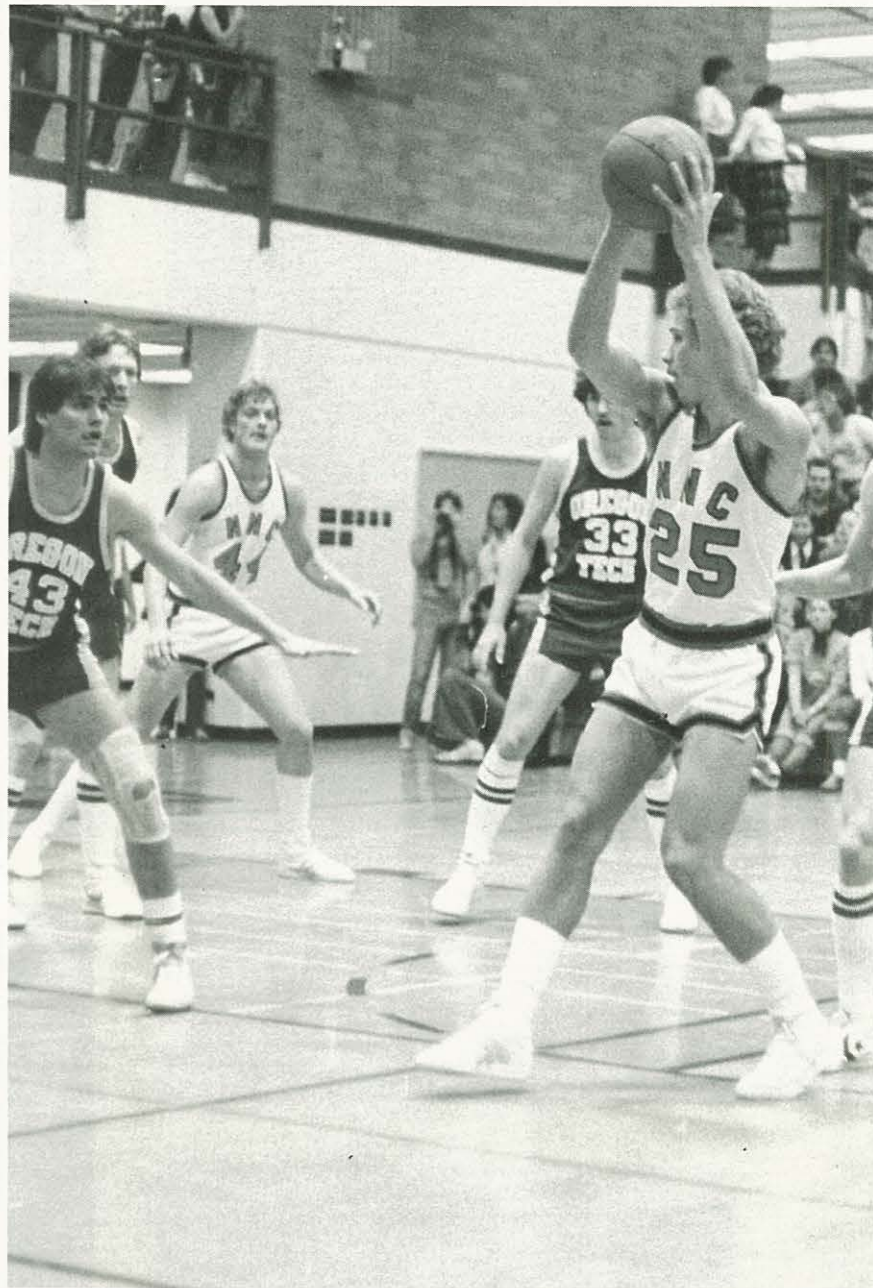

*Not being one of the tallest members of the team did not slow Tony Stone down. He was a crucial player for NNC and led in assists with a total of 123.*

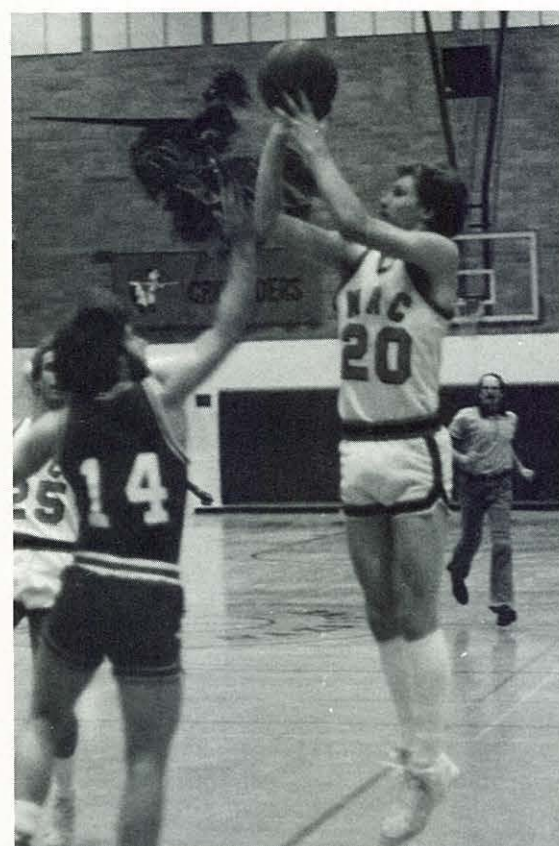

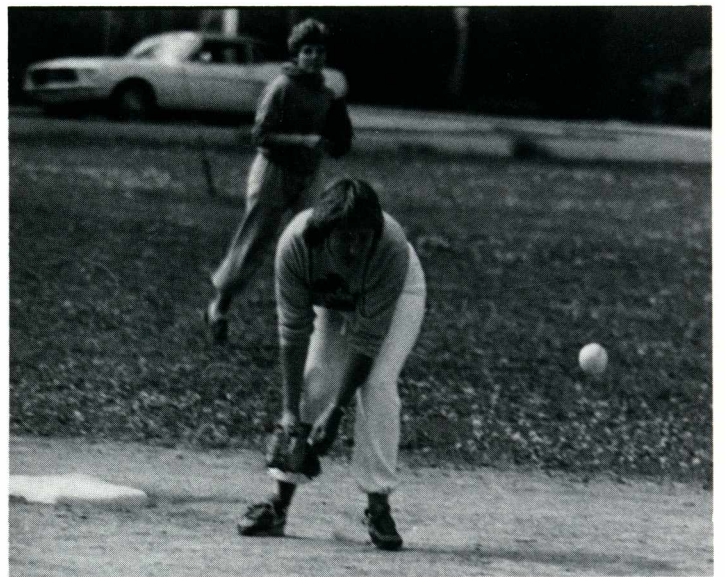
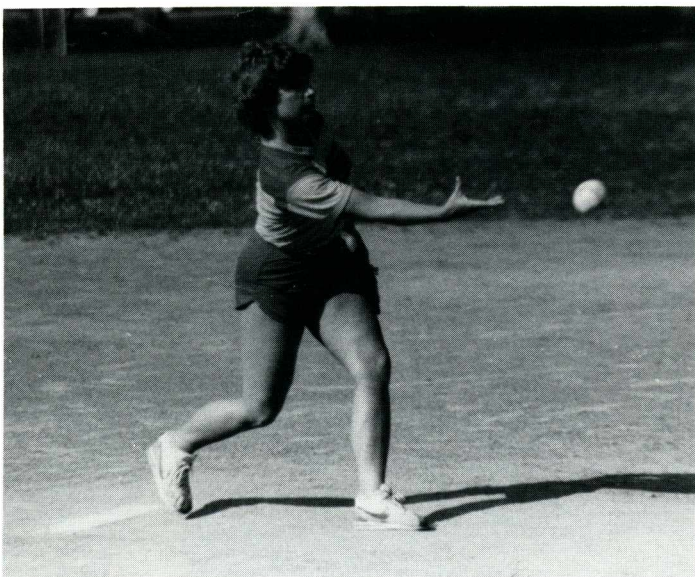
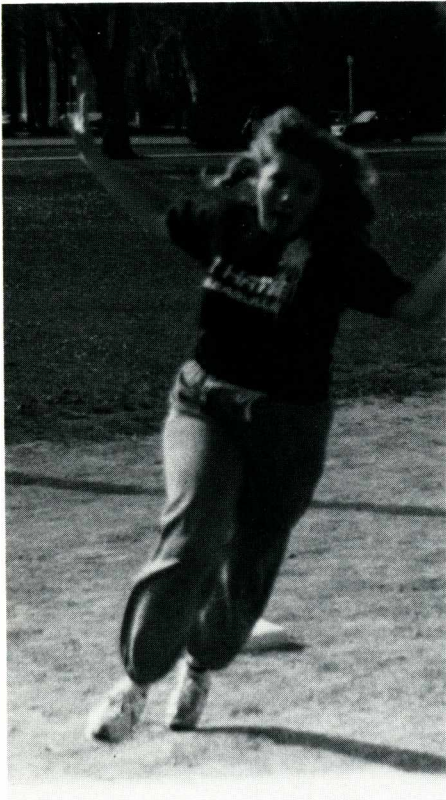








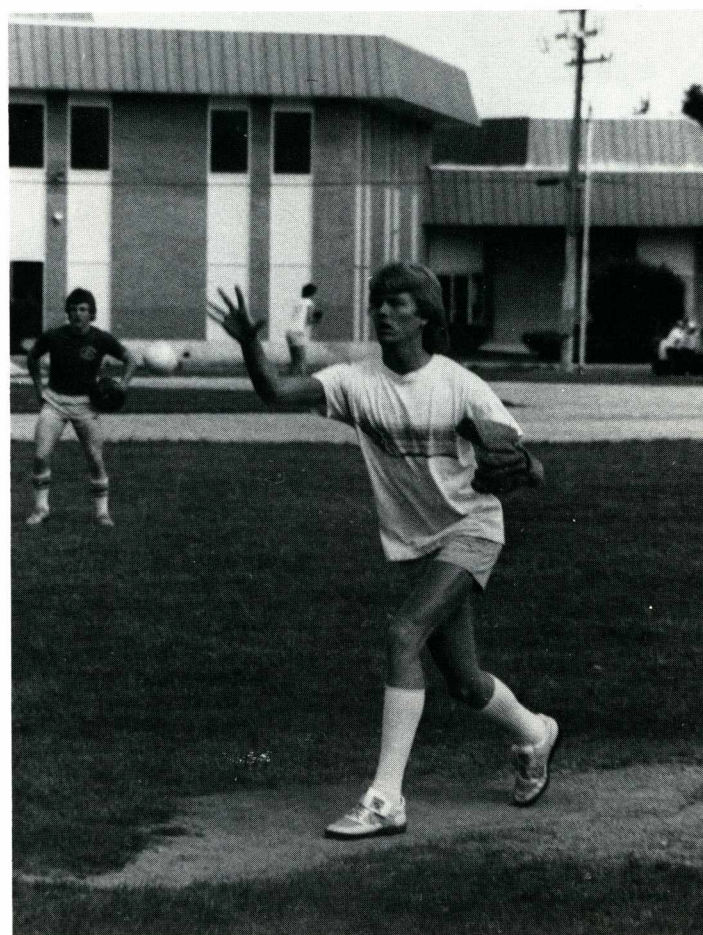
## Take Me Out To

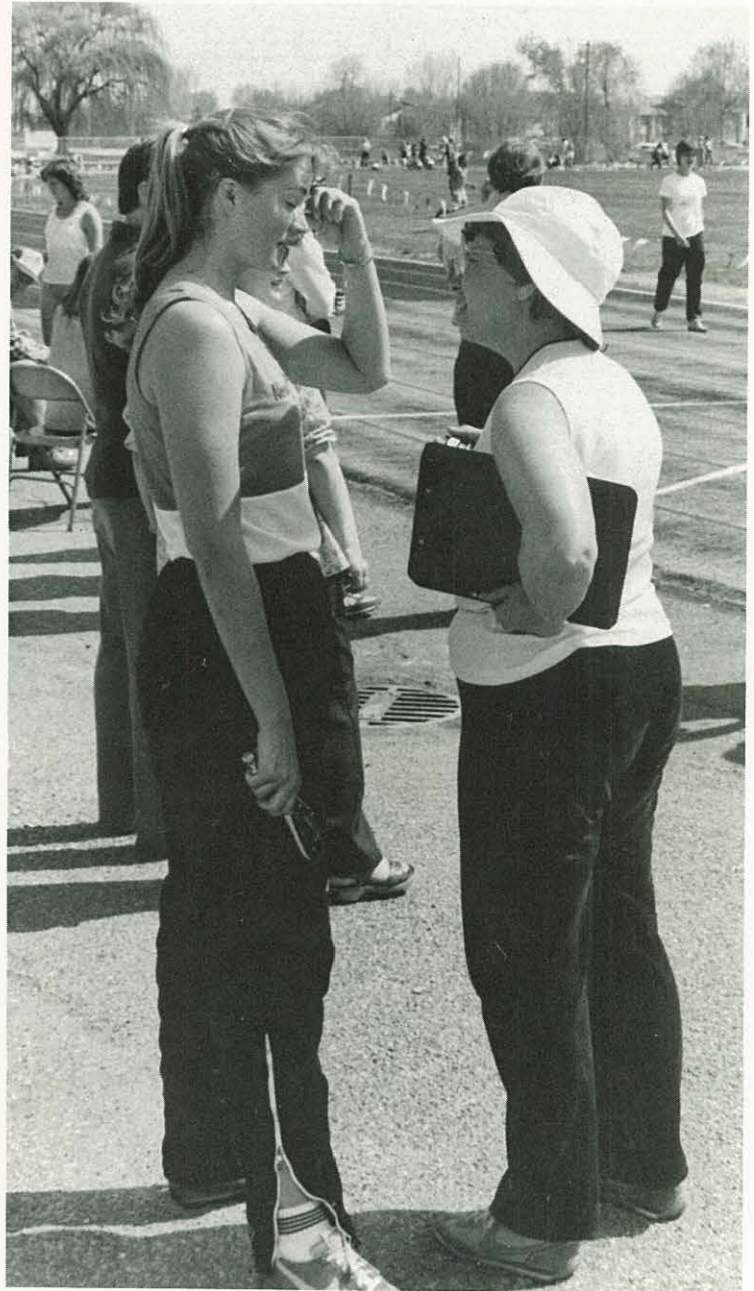
## SANDY EARLY ALL-AMERICAN

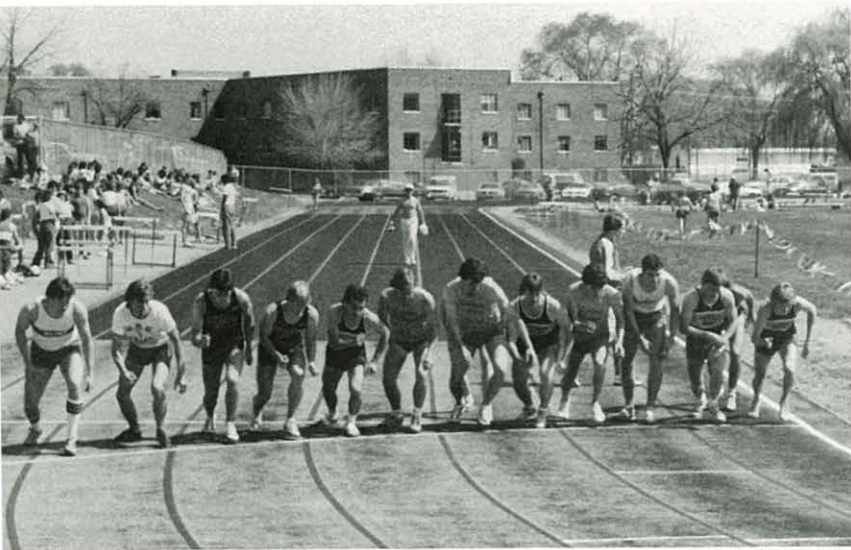




## CRUSADER MEN ON THE MOVE

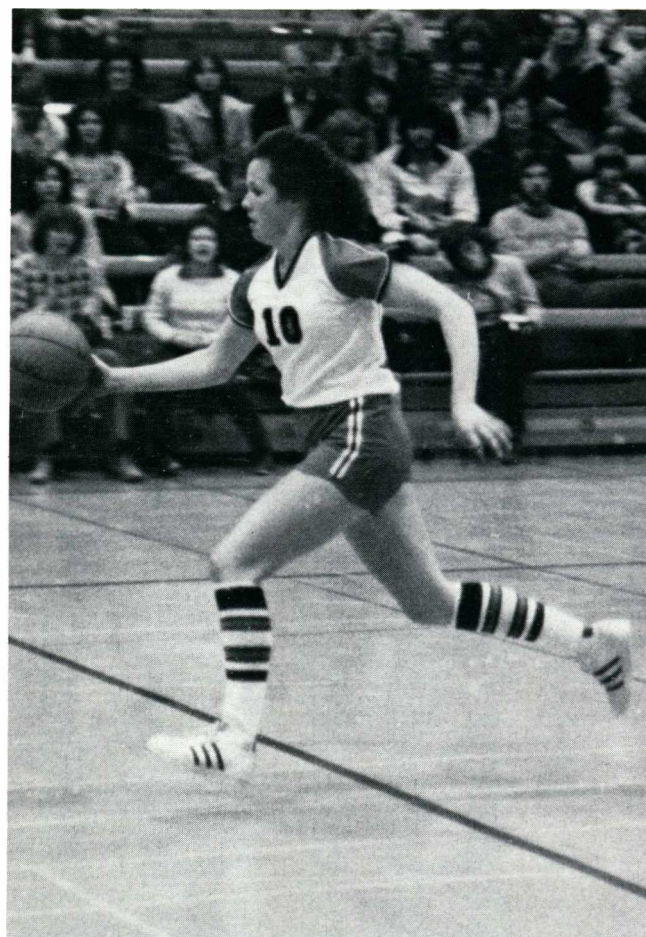




# LINDA GRIM HOPKINS HUMPHREY AWARD

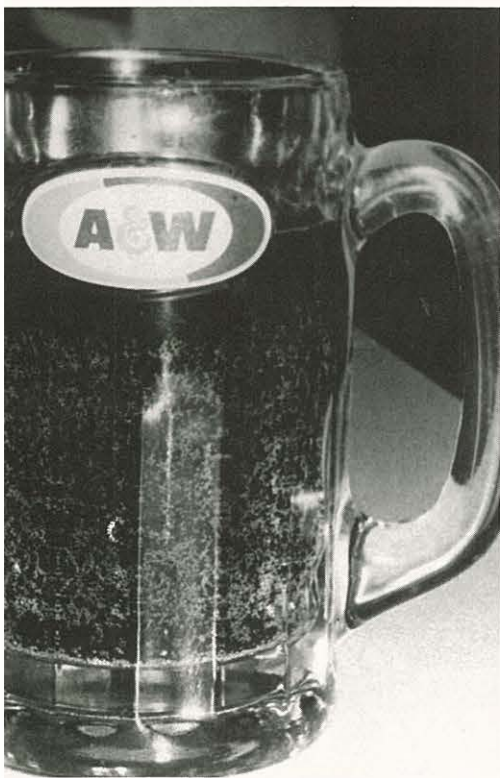
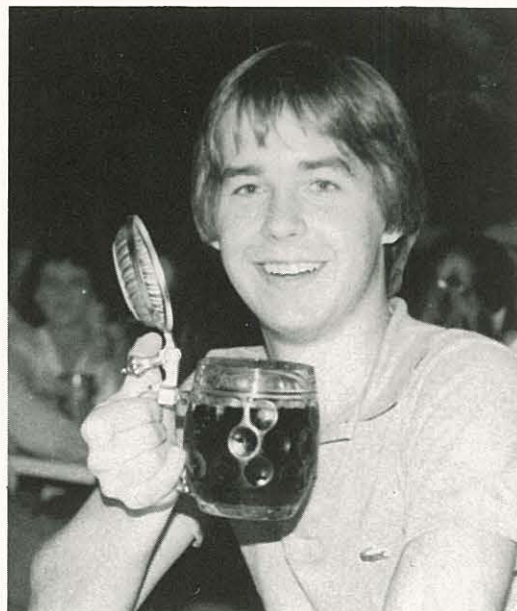








## Rootbeer Fest

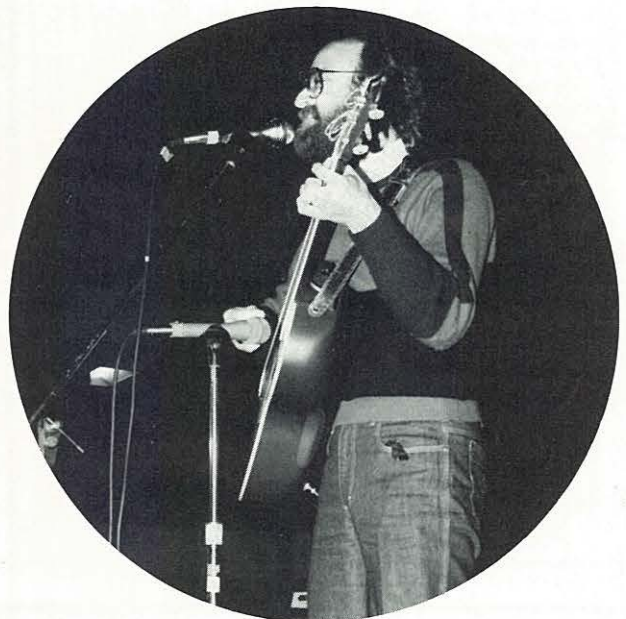
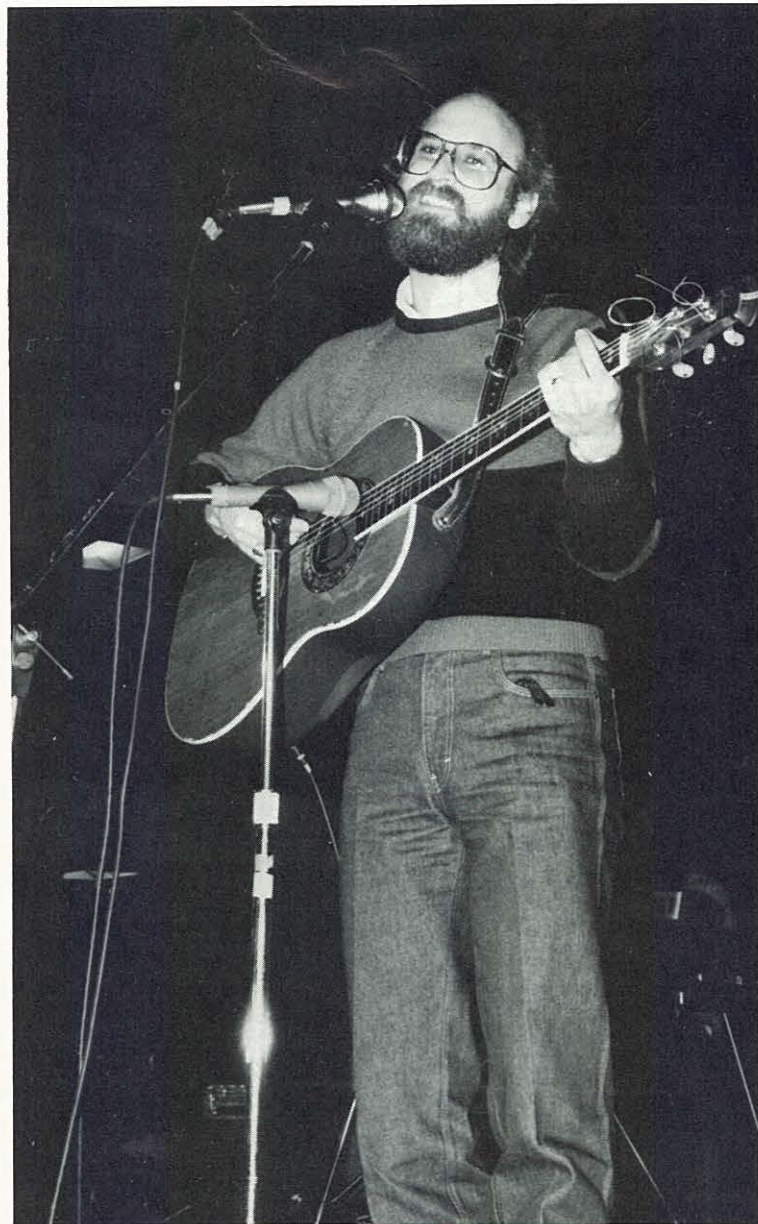


## John Fischer And Kathy Triccoli

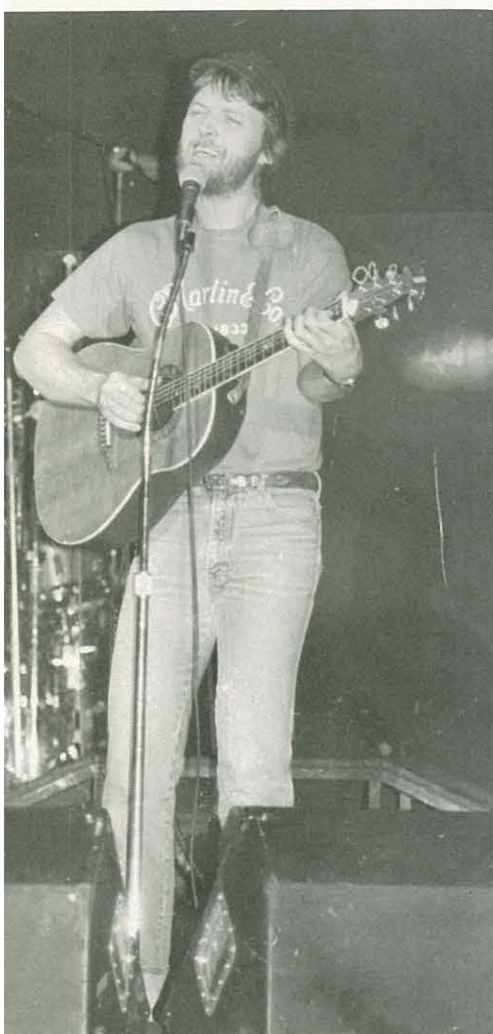
# Silverwind

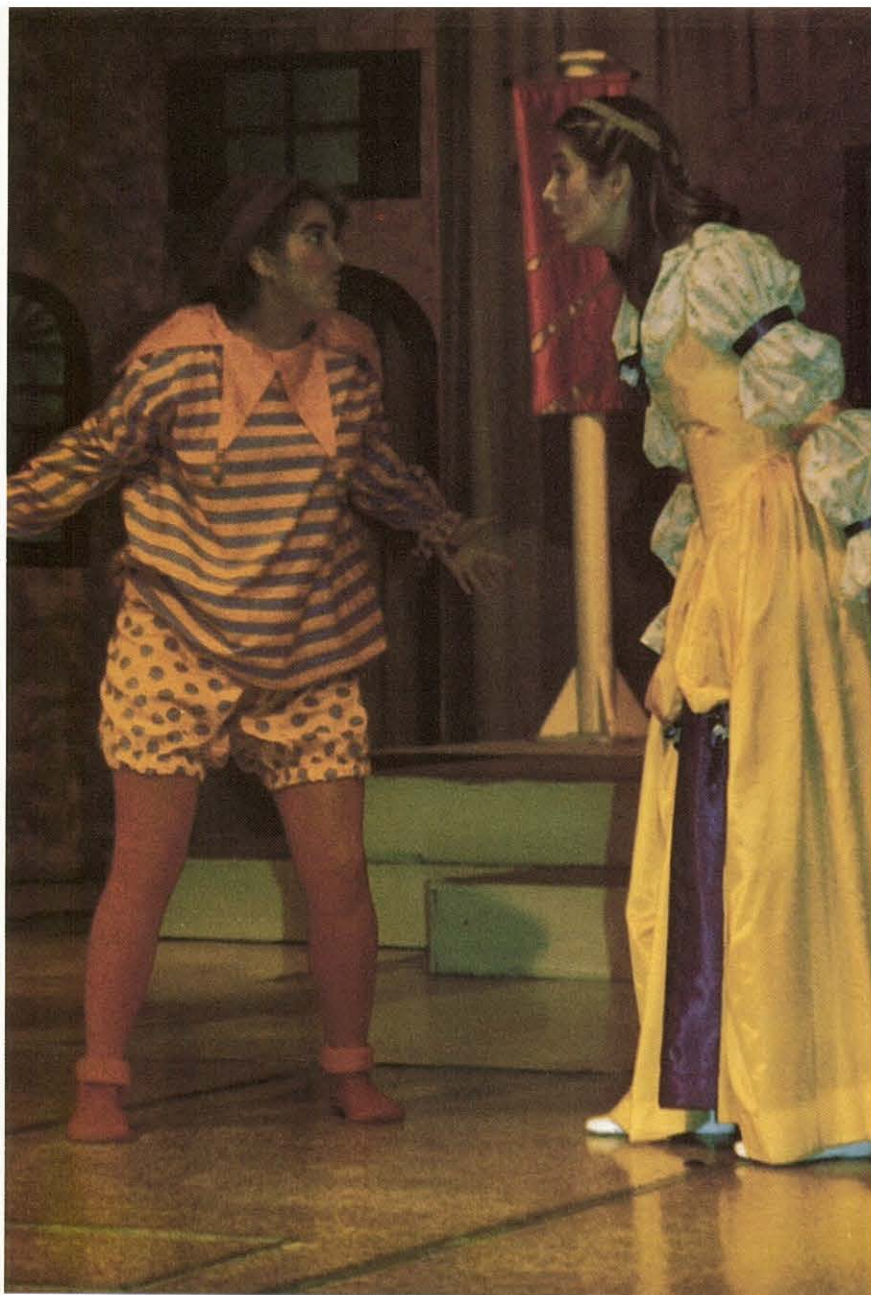

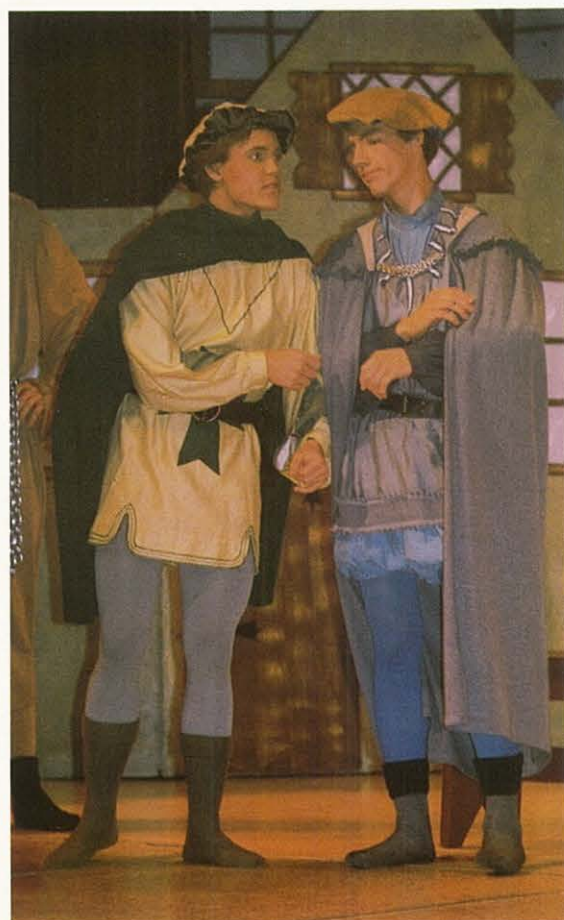
## The Comedy Of Errors

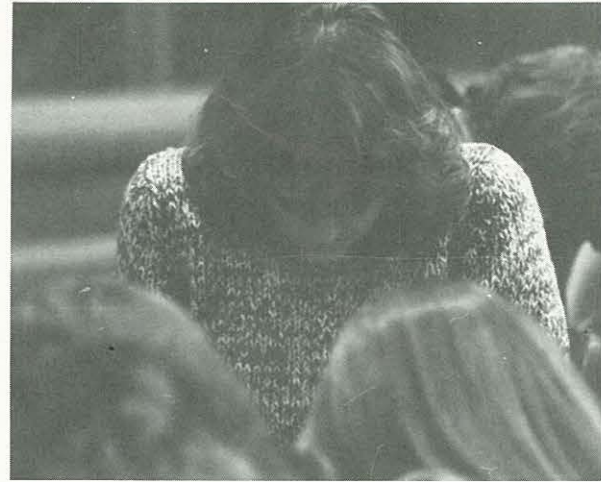






## Fall Revival

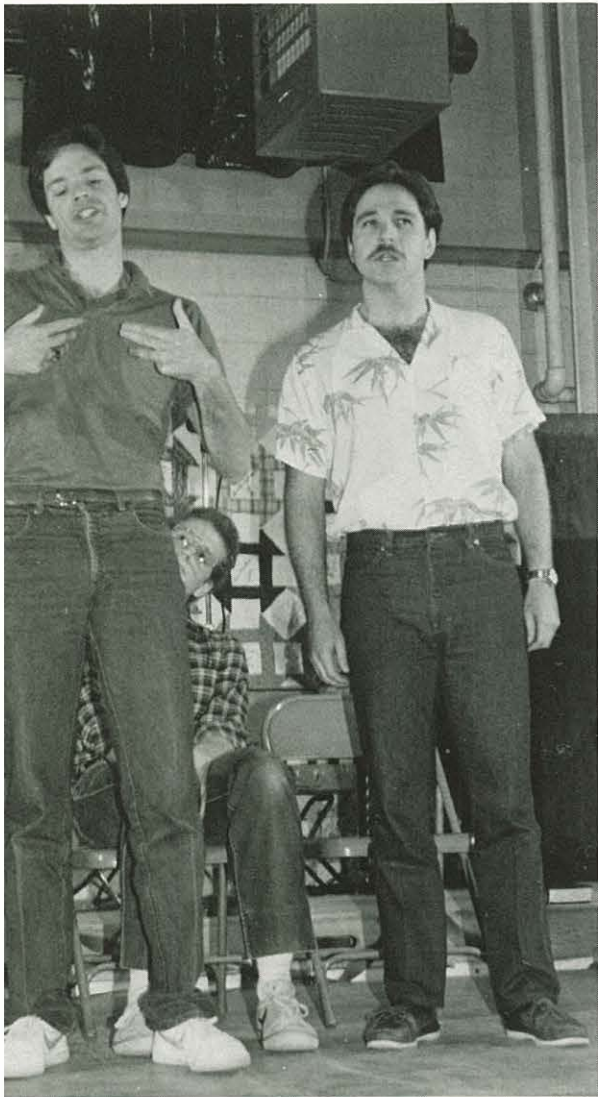


## Blue Jeans Bash
