# 1st Bde CO aids chopper casualties

TAN AN—"Chopper down," crackled a voice over the head-phones of the 9th Division's 1st Brigade command and control (C&C) chopper. At the same moment, all eyes turned toward the glowing fireball on the ground.

Twice the brigade commander's chopper circled the area as a gunship team of 3d Squadron, 5th Cavalry Huey Cobras and LOH "Warwagons" sped to the scene. Colonel Ira A. Hunt Jr., 1st Brigade commander, barked again and the Warwagon pulled up sharply. The watchful Cobras zeroed in on their target.

As the C&C ship began another pass, Hunt's voice came clearly over the intercom: "Take us down there. I want to see what's going on." The pilot responded immediately, dropping the chopper into an open rice paddy.

Within minutes, Hunt was with the infantrymen of Company C. Seconds later an explosion occurred in the flaming chopper. Then a secondary explosion, apparently caused by the downed chopper's rockets, catapulted a



# 2d-47th shifts from Bearcat to Dong Tam


